Note:

The points allocated for size has now been cut by 50% and to maintain the overall 100 total points available, a new section has been introduced in all three categories and this will be for the overall presentation of the exhibit.

The tank.

Should be large enough to allow the fish/s being exhibited therein, adequate space to move around. The tank itself should be presentable, that is to say clean and free of blemishes, such as fingerprints or scratches. Any tape used to edge the tank (only black is allowed), should not hinder the viewable area. The same applies to excess silicone that restricts the viewing area.

Water.

The condition of the water a fish/s is exhibited in should be clean, clear and free of debris. Where species require specific water conditions such as those from 'Black water' rivers and streams, it will be permitted to presented these fishes in tanks with water having a ting of natural colour.
